

## **What are you doing?**

This Circle Game can practice verb vocabulary, and produce a lot of laughs!

Participants / students / children are seated (or standing) in a circle, and the teacher is in the circle too.

1. The first person (or the teacher) starts performing an action or mime – e.g. they act out brushing their teeth (but they don't say anything).
2. The person next to them asks them "What are you doing?"
3. They reply by describing a different action – e.g. "I'm riding my bike".
4. The person who asked must then begin miming that action (riding a bike).
5. The next person asks them "What are you doing?"
6. They reply by describing a different action – e.g. "I'm eating my breakfast".

*Continue on around the circle.*
