A Night in the Jungle

Teaching Notes:

1. The picture:

Ask children to look carefully at the picture of the jungle.

Can you see any creatures or animals in the picture?

If there were any big animals in the jungle (e.g. tigers – where would they be? Among the trees on the other side of the river? Swimming in the river?)

How much of them would you see? (Just the eyes and ears? Just patches between the trees?)

What about if a spaceship landed in the jungle? (What would be in the ship? What would it look like?)

Ask the children to

- draw in something extra
- colour in the picture

2. The story:

Ask the children to think of a story in 3 parts – beginning, middle and end.

Beginning: - they find themselves in the jungle (how? why? when?)

Middle: - they hear/see something scary (what do they see? why is it scary?)

End: - everything is OK because they get rescued / the scary thing turns out not to be scary

3. The plan:

Guide children into making some kind of plan – not necessarily with words.
